- 1.\* When assessing the pitch for seam and/or spin movement, it is the “protected area” only that should be considered and the relative skill and ability of bowlers should also be taken into account.
2. Post match consultation with captains is encouraged in order to determine a ‘fair mark’ for the pitch.
